The majority of the scholarships on this list do not require a Social Security number, legal residency or citizenship. As a general rule, if an application asks for a Social Security number and you do not have one yet, leave that space blank but fill out and turn in the application. Lying about your legal status or providing a false Social Security is a federal offense. Keep in mind that family savings and fundraising can also supplement educational costs.
