Parking Permit Application 2019-2020

All cars parked on campus during the school hours are required to have a valid MTHS parking permit – **EVEN** if you are a Running Start or part-time student. Permits are sold on a first come – first serve basis. Permits must be hung on the rearview mirror and be clearly visible at all times. It is your **RESPONSIBILITY** to transfer your permit between cars if you drive more than one car. All cars must be registered.

COST: To be eligible to purchase a parking permit all fines must be paid in full. The cost of a permit is \$50.00. **Replacement for lost or stolen permits will be \$50.** Permits are non-refundable and non-transferable, even if withdrawing. Permits may be purchased in the fines office. Beginning February 1st, the cost of a permit will be reduced by \$5 a month.

License: All drivers are legally required to have a valid driver's license. You must show your driver's license before you may buy a permit.

Insurance: While we do not require you to show us your proof of auto insurance, State law directs that you have auto insurance.

Student cars are off-limits during the school day. Students may not hang out in the parking lot during school hours. Cars may not be driven off campus during the school day unless the student has an appropriate pass.

Where to Park: You must park in your assigned area of the student parking lot only; with a clearly displayed permit. Cars that are illegally parked, parked without a visible permit, parked in staff/visitor/handicapped/other designated parking spots will be ticketed, or in some cases towed. If there are no parking spots left in your section of the parking lot, you will need to park in the back of the school and let Mrs. Scherich know.

Parking Violations: As a permit holder, you agree to operate your vehicle in a legal and safe manner at all times. Parking on campus is a privilege not a right. Any dangerous/careless driving or infraction of the parking rules may result in ticketing (\$30 per each infraction), towing (up to \$300), loss of parking privileges, suspension from school and/or a police referral.

Mountlake Terrace High School and the Edmonds School district are not responsible for theft or damage to your vehicle. The parking lot is not continuously supervised and students park at their own risk.
